<u>Call to Order</u> – The Meeting of the Saint Louis MHB Trustees was called to order at 5:47 p.m. by Chair Linda Grayson.

<u>Community Comments</u> – There were no Community Members present who wished to address the Trustees.

<u>Approval of the June 2021 Board Minutes</u> – The motion was made by Carolyn Jackson and seconded by Phil Minden to approve the June 17, 2021, Board Meeting Minutes as distributed. The motion passed unanimously.

## **Resolutions to Approve Additional Federal Funding**

The Trustees voted on two U.S. Department of Health and Human Services – Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration awards. On the first resolution Mary Calzaretta made a motion which was seconded by Carolyn Jackson to accept \$601,700 in federal funding for Community Project Funding. The motion passed unanimously. On the second resolution, Donna Schmitt made a motion which was seconded by Rob Poirier to accept an additional \$50,000 in federal funding from ReCAST. The resolution passed unanimously.
